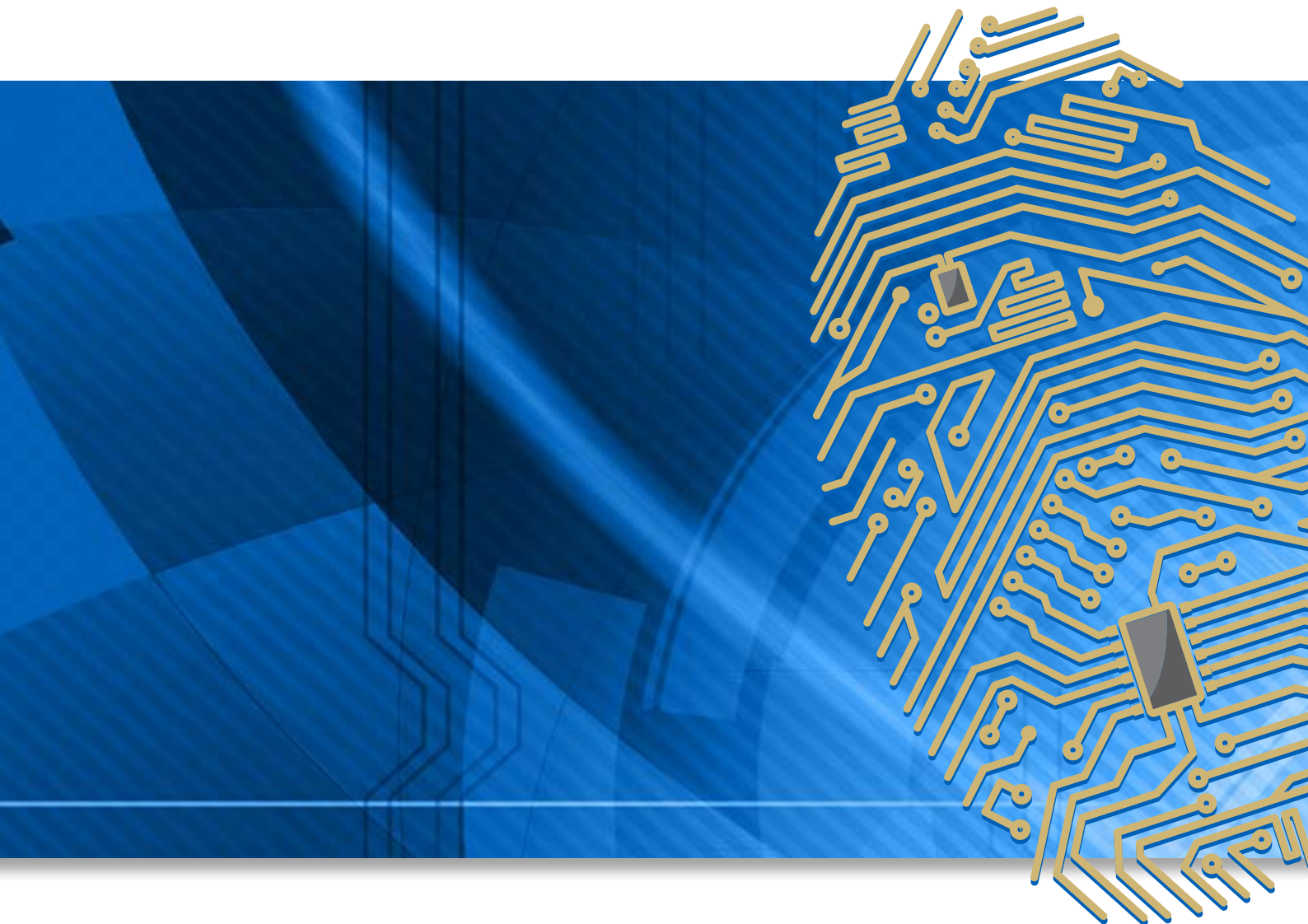

ACISP 2015 offers an excellent opportunity to:

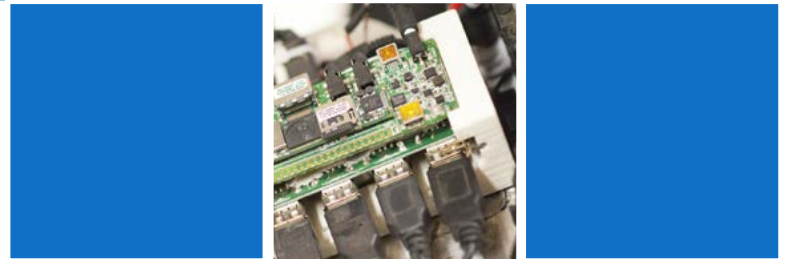
- ▶ engage with researchers from academia and industry and facilitate discussions around the rapidly changing landscape of information security and privacy
